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Rose Construction Office Building, Olathe, Kan.

Products: The building size is 14,500 square feet (1347 m²) with varying lengths and widths, as well as varying eave heights of 10 feet to 18 feet (4 m to 5 m). The building utilizes a Columbus, Neb.-based Behlen Building Systems frame system and is built on pre-cast concrete exterior walls. The roof is a Behlen ADP-1 roof system in Galvalume.

American State Bank Annex, Lubbock, Texas

PEOPLE: architect, Cox/Dirks Architects, Lubbock, and builder, Teinert Commercial Building Services, Lubbock

PRODUCTS: This is a single-slope structure manufactured by Mid-West Steel Building Co., Houston. The building includes the Mid-West 24-gauge Double-Lok roof panels with a roof slope of 25:12. Mid-West Steel Building supplied the complete second-floor mezzanine system and framing for the project. The building also has parapet walls and a radius front wall.

FINE POINTS: Completed in summer 2004, the 60,000-square-foot (5574-m²) American State Bank Annex was the 2005 Building of the Year for Mid-West Steel Building. The impressive structure offers mezzanine floors and remarkable decorative towers. A full-block long and half-block deep, the prominent office building is a flagship symbol of the renovation of downtown Lubbock.
